

California Health Plan Industry Strong Through the Third Quarter of 2012

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California Healthcare News



California health plans were mostly profitable through September 30, 2012 as 25 of the largest 35 plans reported positive net income. The results were somewhat lower than the same period in 2011 when all but 4 of the largest 35 plans were profitable.

Our report on page 2 shows Total Revenues, Administrative Expenses and Net Income for the largest thirty-five domestic health plans operating in California for the periods ending September 30,

2012 and September 30, 2011.

All information in this report was obtained through publicly available data on the California Department of Managed Health Care (DMHC) web site. However, the DMHC web site doesn't incorporate post-close adjustments so adjustments were made to the figures when requested by the plans.

Information not required to be filed with the DMHC (self-insured and parts of California insured business from non-domestic carriers) is not included in this report nor is it referenced in this article.

We prepared this report so a user could quickly determine whether the health plan industry is or isn't doing well. As such, significant analysis of the numbers is beyond the scope of this article. However, there are a few items that should be noted.

Revenues

Thirty plans reported increased revenues for the first nine month period of 2012. Changes in enrollment aside, this demonstrates

plans are able to push rates upward. From a net income perspective, raising premiums is much easier than controlling costs so it's a good thing for the industry if it can move rates upward.

Administrative Expenses

Thirty-one of the plans had higher administrative expenses for the first nine months of 2012 versus the same period in 2011. Was this due entirely to healthcare reform? Will plan customers continue to pay for these increases in administrative expenses?

Net Income

A significant majority of plans reported a profit through the first nine months of 2012 even though healthcare reform has started and costs are more difficult to estimate and include in premiums.

Industry summary

In general, the California Health Plan industry continues to be stable and is in good financial shape. This bodes well for bigger reform changes coming in late 2013.
